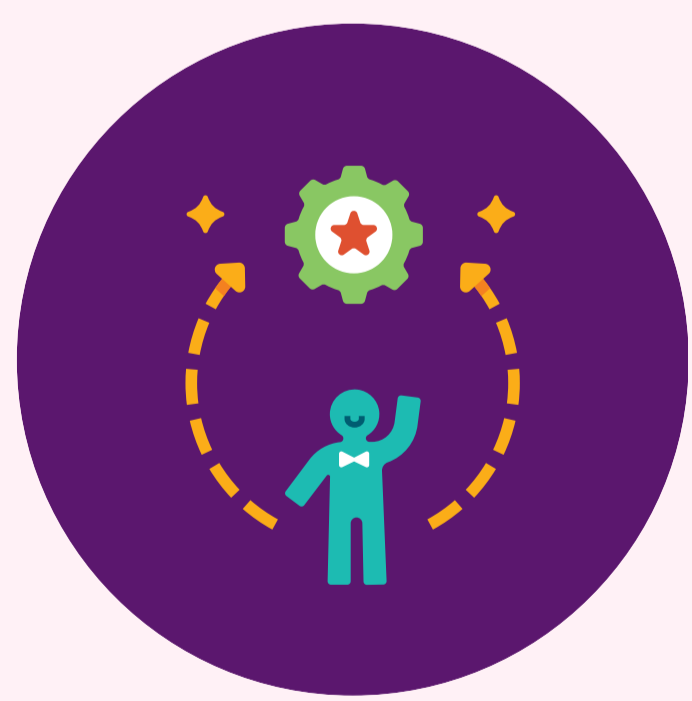
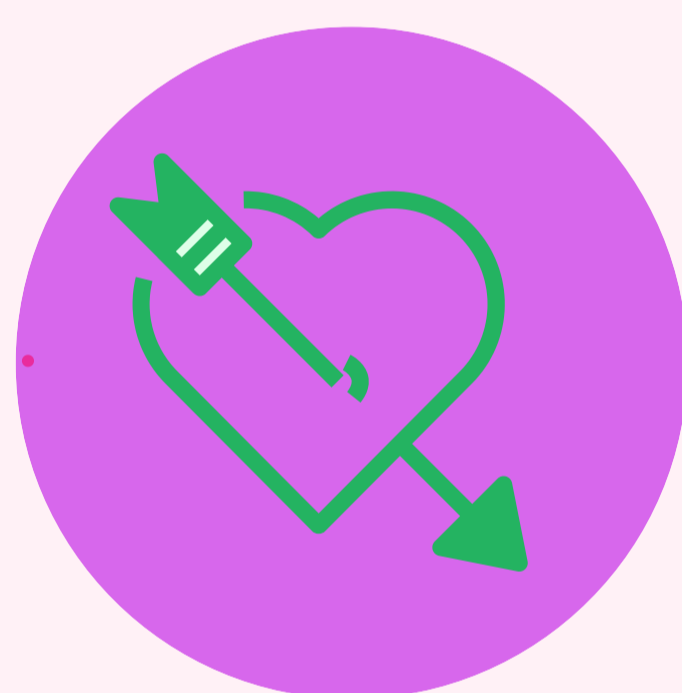


Tiger Woods Ex-Wife
